Hello neighbour,

We are writing to let you know that BC Housing, through the Provincial Rental Housing Corporation, has purchased the property at 280 McIntosh Road in Kelowna. In response to an urgent need for more affordable housing in the community, we will be developing up to 50 studio homes with supports for Kelowna residents who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness, to be operated by the John Howard Society of Central and South Okanagan (JHCSO.) The site is zoned RM5 Multiple Unit Residential, which is appropriate for supportive housing. BC Housing will be submitting a development permit to the City of Kelowna.

We understand that you may have some questions about the plan for this housing. Please drop in to a Neighbourhood Information Session to learn more about the housing, see renderings of the building and have questions answered by representatives of BC Housing, Interior Health and JHCSO:

Time: 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm

Place: Rutland Centennial Hall, 215 Shepherd Road

Supportive housing is a self-contained studio home with supports provided on-site, to ensure people can achieve and maintain housing stability. Applicants will go through a thorough assessment process to ensure an appropriate mix of residents with the right supports. All residents will sign a program agreement (similar to a tenancy agreement) and will pay rent.
